

Dutch Fork Homeschool Resource Center Registration Information

Thank you for your interest in Dutch Fork Homeschool Resource Center! DFHRC is a resource center and **not** a school. We are committed to assisting you and your family on your homeschool journey by offering top-quality, Christ-centered instruction in subject areas in which parents/students need some assistance. Students are welcome to take only one or as many classes as they like. Our extremely knowledgeable instructors teach material, provide assignments, and award grades for grade reports, **however, you, the parent, are still responsible for the education of your child**; therefore, please maintain a high level of supervision over your student's work and help us hold him/her accountable for the assignments we provide. From time to time we may request that you administer a take-home test, sign off on an assignment, or document time spent on homework. **It is imperative that all homework assignments are completed in a timely manner in order for us to provide the weekly instruction necessary for satisfactory course completion.**

LOCATION AND MEETING DAY: Classes are held at **Chapin Baptist Church, 950 Old Lexington Highway, Chapin, SC 29036**. Most classes meet only on Mondays, however, Spanish meets Mondays and Fridays. Chemistry meets Mondays and an occasional Fridays, due to labs.*

HOW TO REGISTER: Complete **Part 1** (Registration Form to include Behavioral Expectations page) and **Part 2** (Course Matrix) and submit electronically via our gmail account (dutchforkhomeschoolresource@gmail.com) OR print out both and snail mail **before June 30th**, along with your registration and science lab fees to:

Your registration will be recorded, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to you and the course instructor(s), and all fees will be delivered to the appropriate parties.

FEES:

1. **Registration/Facility Fee** – a non-refundable registration/facility fee - **\$100 for returning families**** and **\$115 for new families** made payable to **Chapin Baptist Church** for the use of their facilities, postmarked no later than **June 30th**.
2. **Tuition** – **\$240 per semester, per class, per student** made payable to individual instructors. Lab sciences are subject to an additional one-time fee of \$15* and all Spanish courses are an additional \$25. **Tuition is due at orientation for 1st semester and the first class day in January for 2nd semester.**
3. **Science lab/supply fees** – One-time fees made payable to the appropriate instructors (see **Part 2, Course Matrix**, for details), postmarked no later than **June 30th**.
4. **Late registration fee** – If classroom space permits, late registrations may be accepted, however, a **\$30 late fee will be required when postmarked after June 30th**. A separate “late fee check” should be made payable to Lisa Baghdady for use as a supply fee to cover additional needs for the center.

*All attempts will be made to complete the labs during the regular Monday course meetings, however, it may be necessary for additional labs to meet on designated Fridays per the instructor's discretion. If this is the case, then the additional fee will be requested at that time. This will be explained further at our orientation in August.

**Returning families are defined as those whose students attended DFHRC the year immediately prior to the year for which they are registering.
